BACKPACK HUNTS

10 DAY DALL SHEEP HUNTS

\$23,500 US

July 14 – 25
July 25 – August 5
August 5 – 16
August 16 – 27
August 27 – September 7

Caribou Option: If you choose to harvest a caribou while hunting sheep, you must pay an additional \$4,500 US after the animal is taken. Caribou season opens July 25.

- Wolf and Wolverine included in all hunts (season opens July 25).
- Please note that you have up to 10 “hunting” days.

15 DAY DALL SHEEP/CARIBOU COMBO HUNTS

\$28,500 US

August 5 – 21
August 21 – September 7
August 27 – September 12

This longer sheep hunt is designed to give the hunter lots of time to look over many rams in search of an exceptional trophy. You have up to 15 “hunting” days, and this hunt includes a Mountain Caribou.

- Moose can be added to the August 21 and August 27 hunts for a trophy fee of \$14,000 US.

16 DAY MIXED-BAG HUNTS

\$42,500 US

September 7 – 24

Dall Sheep, Alaska/Yukon Moose, Mountain Caribou, Wolf, Wolverine.

- Please note that you have up to 16 “hunting” days.

12 DAY SHEEP/MOOSE COMBO HUNTS

\$32,500 US

September 7 – 20

- Mountain Caribou may also be taken on this hunt for a trophy fee of \$4,500 US.

10 DAY MOOSE/CARIBOU COMBO HUNTS

\$27,500 US

September 20 – 30

- Wolf and Wolverine are included in this hunt.

8 DAY MOUNTAIN CARIBOU HUNTS

1 GUIDE / 2 HUNTERS \$9,500 US per hunter
1 GUIDE / 1 HUNTER \$12,500 US

September 12 – 21
September 21 – 30

- Wolf and Wolverine are included in this hunt.
- Moose can be added to the 1x1 caribou hunt for a trophy fee of \$14,000
- The September 21 hunt is the last hunt of the season; the hunt is over when your caribou is harvested.

10 DAY HIGH-COUNTRY MOUNTAIN CARIBOU HUNTS

1 GUIDE / 2 HUNTERS \$11,500 US per hunter

August 5 – 16
August 16 – 27
August 27 – September 7

This longer caribou hunt is designed to give the hunters more time to look over more bulls in search of an outstanding trophy. This hunt is ideal for bowhunters.

- Wolf and Wolverine are included in this hunt.
- Please note that you have up to 10 “hunting” days.

TERMS OF PAYMENT & OTHER INFORMATION

All hunts are payable in US funds. All hunts booked are subject to the Canadian Government Goods & Services Tax. Fortunately for all non-Canadians, we only have to charge you 2.5% tax on the hunt package price, not 5% (only if the hunt balance is paid prior to April 15 of the hunt year). All other prices are subject to the 5% tax. A deposit of 1/3 of the total cost of the hunt is required to reserve a booking date. The second 1/3 is required by November 1 prior to your hunt year and the balance plus tax must be paid by April 15 of your hunt year. Personal checks are acceptable for all hunt payments. Optional game harvested is subject to the 5% tax and must be paid by cash, cashier's checks or traveler's checks. Hunt deposits are non-refundable but it may be possible to move your hunt to another year if time permits to find a satisfactory replacement hunter at full price. You then must pay the published hunt price of the year you are moving your hunt to and a transfer fee. A hunt date is considered booked and confirmed only after the initial deposit is received. Should two deposits arrive for the same hunt date, the first deposit received takes priority. All hunters are required to sign a Risk & Release Form prior to arriving in Norman Wells.

ADDITIONAL COSTS

Hunting Licenses: \$100 CDN per species hunted (\$105 with the government tax);
Trophy Fees – paid to the N.W.T. Government only after your trophy is taken): Sheep, Caribou, Moose – \$400 CDN each (\$420 with the government tax); Wolf & Wolverine: \$200 CDN each (\$210 with the government tax).
Non-Resident Hunting Preservation Fund (NRHPF) is currently \$100 and will be noted on your final statement. **Bush flying from Norman Wells to the base-camp** (return) is \$1,700 CDN per person (plus 5% tax) at the time of writing (11/2016). This will fluctuate with fuel/charter rate prices. This is payable to the charter operator prior to leaving Norman Wells. If you arrive late or want to leave earlier than your scheduled change date, you must pay the extra charter fees on top of your scheduled charter fee.
If you want to hire a “packer” to help you pack your gear, it is \$375 US per day, plus tax. We make all arrangements for you in advance. **The non-hunter companion fee** is \$375 US per day plus tax and the regular charter fee.
